

ORDINANCE NO. 7633

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR, RECEIVE AND ADMINISTER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, ALLOCATION PROGRAM, FUNDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency allocates Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds to local units of general government to assist with costs incurred to address local needs through activities that advance Federal objectives; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Defiance desires to undertake and carry out Community Development Activities that are eligible for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funding under Title I of the Housing & Community Development Act of 1974; and,

WHEREAS, the City is eligible for an award of \$75,000 in Community Development Allocation Funding for Fiscal Year 2014, and,

WHEREAS, Council must authorize the City Administrator to act in connection with the application by an Ordinance of record;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to enter into a contract with the Ohio Development Services Agency for financial assistance under Title I of the Housing & Community Development Act of 1974, as amended to date, and in connection therewith, to:

- a) Prepare and file all documents necessary to make application to the Ohio Development Services Agency for a grant of financial assistance under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Fiscal Year 2014 Community Development Allocation Program;
- b) Certify that the City will replace all occupied and vacant occupiable low/moderate income dwelling units demolished or converted to a use other than as low/moderate income housing as a direct result of activities assisted with funds provided under the Housing and Community Development Act in conformity with regulations promulgated at 24 CFR 570.496(a); and,
- c) Execute and carry out all programs and activities set forth in the application for Community Development Block Grant Allocation Program funding.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law including, but not limited to, Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the community for the reason that immediate filing of the authorized application is required to receive consideration by the Ohio Development Services Agency. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than 5 Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 7634

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR, RECEIVE AND ADMINISTER FY 2014 SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM, ASSISTANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency allocates Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds to local units of general government to assist with costs incurred to address local needs through activities that advance Federal objectives; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Defiance desires to participate in the FY 2014 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant, Community Development Critical Infrastructure Program, to undertake and carry out Community Development activities that are eligible for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, Council must authorize the City Administrator to act in connection with the application by an Ordinance of record;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is designated as the official representative of the City of Defiance, Ohio, for all purposes relating to the municipality's participation in the Ohio Development Services Agency, FY 2014 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant, Community Development Critical Infrastructure Program.

Section 2: The City Administrator is authorized to submit an application to the Ohio Development Services Agency for FY 2014 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant, Community Development Critical Infrastructure Program, assistance and provide all information and documentation requested in support of the application.

Section 3: Council acknowledges that participation in the program requires compliance with Federal and State laws, regulations and program guidelines. The City Administrator is directed to administer such funds as may be received and all work undertaken with Small Cities Community Development Block Grant assistance in strict conformity with all applicable statutory laws, State and Federal Regulations and Community Development Critical Infrastructure Program guidelines. The City Administrator is authorized to provide such assurances, information and documentation as may be requested by the Ohio Development Services Agency to demonstrate compliance with statutory, regulatory and guideline requirements in making application for and administration of funds allocated to the municipality pursuant to the authorized application.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law including, but not limited to, Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the community for the reason that immediate filing of the authorized application is required to receive consideration by the Ohio Development Services Agency. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than 5 Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.
