

Ordinance No. 7626

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A COMBINATION SALT AND BRINE SPREADER

WHEREAS, Ordinance 7445, passed November 20, 2012, authorized the purchase of a small, pick-up truck mounted, anti-ice unit as a demonstration platform to evaluate the efficacy and cost effectiveness of liquid anti-icing and de-icing agents; and,

WHEREAS, pre-wetted salt dispensed as brine proved to be a more effective anti-icing and de-icing agent than rock salt alone and demonstrated significant potential to reduce costs by reducing the amount of salt needed to combat ice formation and shortening the amount of time and labor required apply anti-icing agents; and,

WHEREAS, the City Administrator solicited proposals to retrofit one truck with a pre-wetting system to enable use of the modified vehicle to dispense both granular and liquid materials to serve a number of functions including dust suppression and ice control; and,

WHEREAS, W.A. Jones Truck Bodies and Equipment submitted the lowest priced proposal to supply and install the desired equipment;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to contract with W.A. Jones Truck Bodies and Equipment to modify and equip one municipal dump truck in the manner described by the proposal dated April 28, 2014 (Quotation No. MACQ3259) and at the quoted price of \$44,359.00.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the contract price from appropriated and appropriately budgeted funds allocated to the purchase by 2014 Budget Line 403-901-5-2-981-024.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective on the earliest date permitted by law.
