

# Ordinance No. 7660

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS

WHEREAS, The Police and Fire Committee has recommended the replacement of fourteen of the twenty-nine self-contained breathing apparatus used by the Division of Fire and Rescue;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to purchase fourteen MSA FireHawk M7XT air masks, 2 receivers and 2 face shield brackets conforming to the product specifications recited in the August 6, 2014, proposal submitted by Fire-Safety Services, Inc., on the terms of sale therein proposed.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the total purchase price of \$58,088.00 from Line 792-336-5-2-730-005 of the 2014 annual budget .

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective on the earliest date permitted by law.

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO LUCAS 2 AUTOMATED CHEST COMPRESSION SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, The Police and Fire Committee has recommended the purchase of two Lucas 2 automated chest compression systems for use by the Division of Fire and Rescue;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to purchase two Lucas 2 automated chest compression systems from Physio-Control, Inc. at a cost of \$12,711.20 each and on the terms of sale established by price quotation 41835-44407.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the total purchase price of \$25,422.40 from Line 792-336-5-2-730-005 of the 2014 annual budget .

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective on the earliest date permitted by law.

# ORDINANCE NO. 7662

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF ONE CATERPILLAR MODEL 938 WHEEL LOADER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, conduct of snow removal operations requires access to a reliable and serviceable wheel loader; and,

WHEREAS, the municipally-owned wheel loader is not reliable due to age and condition; and,

WHEREAS, Council desires to complete a comprehensive study of municipal equipment needs before authorizing the purchase of a replacement; and,

WHEREAS, competitive quotations were solicited to supply leased equipment suitable for use during the 2014-2015 winter season and The Ohio Cat Rental Store submitted the preferred proposal;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to lease one Caterpillar Model 938 wheel loader from The Ohio Cat Rental Store for use during the period of December, 2014, through March, 2015, on the terms recited in the accepted proposal.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay expenses arising under the terms of the authorized equipment lease from Line 204-446-5-2-941-003 of the 2014 annual budget and lawfully available funds appropriated for that purpose by the 2015 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health and safety of the community for the reason that immediate commitment to the proposed lease is required to assure that the necessary equipment will be reserved for municipal use during the 2014-2015 winter season. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than 5 Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.
