

# ORDINANCE NO. 7786

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO CONTRACT WITH AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City entered into a Contract with URS Corporation to provide engineering and technical services necessary to the development of a revised CSO Long Term Control Plan acceptable to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, United States Environmental Protection Agency and Court of Common Pleas of Defiance County; and,

WHEREAS, the revised CSO Long Term Control Plan was developed over a period of more than three years by URS Corporation and its corporate successor, AECOM Technical Services, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, the revised CSO Long Term Control Plan was filed with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency in August, 2015, and is presently undergoing regulatory review in anticipation of further proceedings in State of Ohio vs. City of Defiance, Ohio, Defiance County Common Pleas Case No. CASE NO. 10-CV-40433; and,

WHEREAS, continuing service from AECOM Technical Services, Inc., is necessary to make such modifications and adjustments to the proposed CSO Long Term Control Plan as may be required to secure regulatory and judicial approval of the Plan;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to execute the \$60,000.00 Lump Sum Work Order proposed by AECOM Technical Services, Inc. pertaining to the provision of engineering and related support services to secure regulatory approval of the 2015 Combined Sewer Overflow Long Term Control Plan now pending review by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and is further authorized to proceed with all activities therein described.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay all costs incurred in accordance with the terms of the Lump Sum Work Order authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance from line 589-540-529-770-015 of the 2016 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health and welfare of the community for the reason that continuing service from AECOM Technical Services, Inc., is essential to proper regulatory review of the proposed CSO Long Term Control Plan and any interruption in the availability of those services will be detrimental to the City's ability to defend its interests in pending litigation. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than 5 Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

# Ordinance No. 7787

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH POGGEMEYER DESIGN GROUP FOR TECHNICAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES TO EXPAND RIVERSIDE CEMETERY

WHEREAS, Poggemeyer Design Group was engaged to develop a "Master Plan for the Expansion of Riverside Cemetery" in 2008; and,

WHEREAS, Phase I of the master plan was implemented under the supervision of Poggemeyer Design Group; and,

WHEREAS, an insufficient number of burial lots remain available for sale in the developed portions of Riverside Cemetery necessitating that further expansion be undertaken in accordance with the 2008 master plan; and,

WHEREAS, the baseball diamond formally known as Tecumseh Park has been removed from the cemetery grounds in preparation for the establishment of approximately 850 additional burial lots; and,

WHEREAS, development of cemetery grounds on the land formerly occupied by Tecumseh Park will require the services of a surveyor and engineering services to design water distribution, storm water management and driveway facilities;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to contract with Poggemeyer Design Group, for surveying, permitting and design services required to implement Phase III of the 2008 Master Plan for Expansion of Riverside Cemetery at a cost of \$28,000.00.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the contract price from funds allocated to Riverside Cemetery expansion by Line 403-901-5-2-978-051 of the 2016 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective on the earliest date permitted by law.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MONTHLY TRANSFERS

**Now, therefore**, be it enacted by the Council of the City of Defiance, Defiance County, Ohio:
