

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is a summarization of the Defiance Police Departments policing activities for the year 2006. We continued to work with a manpower shortage throughout 2006 due mostly to the retirement of two long time veterans of the Defiance Police Department. We have hired three new officers in 2006 to replace the two retirees and one officer who resigned deciding to return to his hometown. But I can tell you that even with the shortages we continued to provide the City of Defiance with great police work with officers who truly care about the safety of our community. The future looks bright with a new patrolman's test being given this past fall and it appears we will be hiring at least two new officers in 2007 bringing us within one officer of ordinance strength.

We have not been able to bring back programs lost in 2005 but we continue to maintain the Defiance /Paulding County Crime Stoppers, the Defiance County Senior Triad and the Third Grade Seatbelt Program. Our bicycle patrol has grown with two new officers being added in 2006. The department's canine unit Sgt. Steve Waldron and his partner Zeus have continued to provide excellent services not only to the city but to surrounding jurisdictions as well.

We are a very young department and one still in transition but we have definitely made strides and will continue to do so in 2007. We don't look to replace the programs lost in 2005 in 2007 until we have leveled out our manpower situation and have gotten our new officers properly trained. We will continue to move in a positive direction and provide our city with the best law enforcement possible.

The Officer's of the Defiance Police Department once again look forward to working with the administration, city council and the citizens of Defiance to continue to make Defiance, "A Great Place to live." We would like to thank the community for the opportunity to serve and encourage all to stop in anytime, our doors are always open.

Dear Ladies and Gentleman:

The Defiance Police Auxiliary had a very good year volunteering 1110.5 hours to the City of Defiance and working an additional 310.5 hours of projecting to cover for full time officers. This reflects an increase in the number of hours volunteered from last year's numbers and the projecting hours has shown an increase from last year as well.

The Police Auxiliary donated hours in areas such as sporting events, holiday parades, the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks event, and in-service training. They also assisted full time officers with their general duties and also area businesses with duties such as security, safety, training and fingerprinting.

The Police Auxiliary began 2006 with 10 members, 5 short of the allowed 15 member roster. The Auxiliary was also down another two officers due to medical leave. For these reasons, the Auxiliary operated approximately half of the year with 8 officers. In June, three more officers were approved and initiated in time to help with security for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks. Two more officers were also sworn in towards the end of 2006 allowing us to end the year with 15 officers, 2 of which are still currently on medical leave.

Attached is a breakdown of officers' hours by activity. The headings; PATROL, TRAINING, PAID PROJECTS, PUBLIC RELATIONS, and ADMINISTRATION & MEETINGS are defined as follows:

**PATROL**- assisting full time officers with their duties. This includes, but is not limited to: traffic stops, complaints, accidents, traffic and crowd control, and court appearances. These are all non-paid hours.

**PAID PROJECTS**- all hours that an Auxiliary officer works for compensation. These hours are first offered to the full time officers and then to members of the Auxiliary. Examples of projecting include security at the mall, special school events, and sporting events.

**TRAINING**- any schooling the officer may take to further enhance his or her knowledge of law

enforcement or to update their current standards. The most common training for an Auxiliary Officer is the Basic Peace Officer Training and qualification to carry a firearm.

**PUBLIC RELATIONS**- any detail that makes the officer visible in the community. This includes details such as manning information booths at the mall, fingerprinting children, and providing security at special events and parades.

**ADMINISTRATION & MEETINGS**- includes time spent in monthly or special meetings. This also includes special committees and report preparation.
